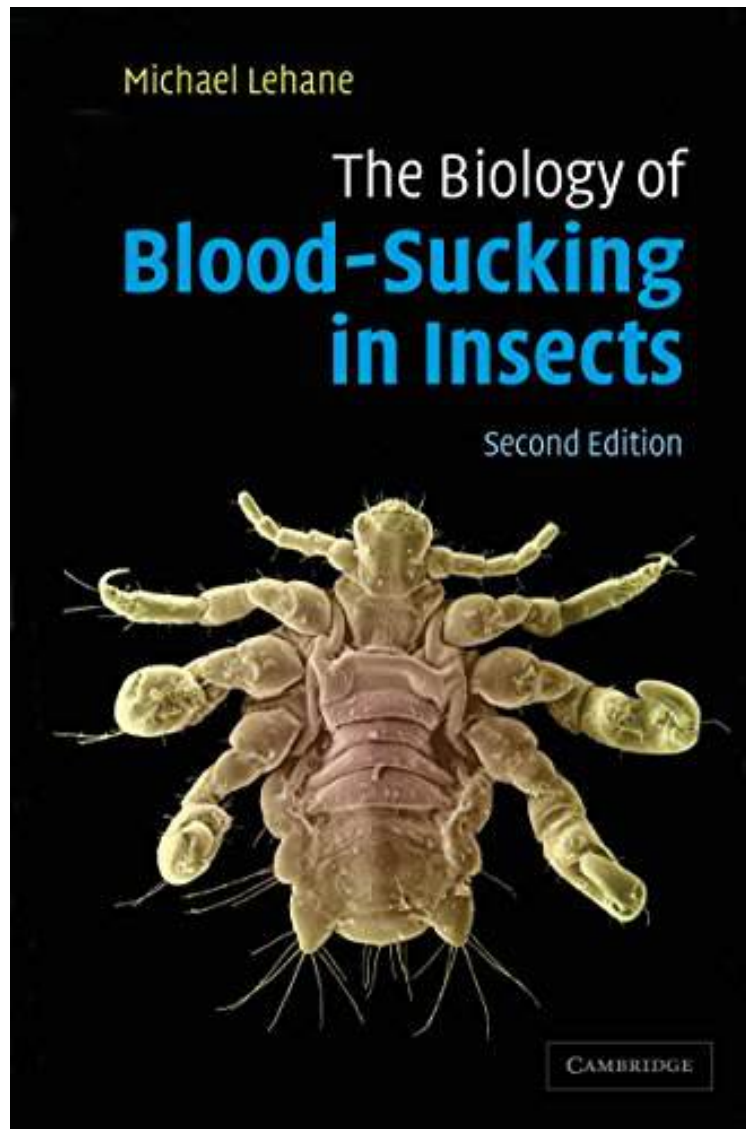


The Biology of Blood-Sucking in Insects
